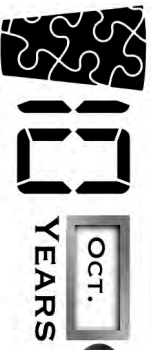

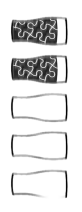

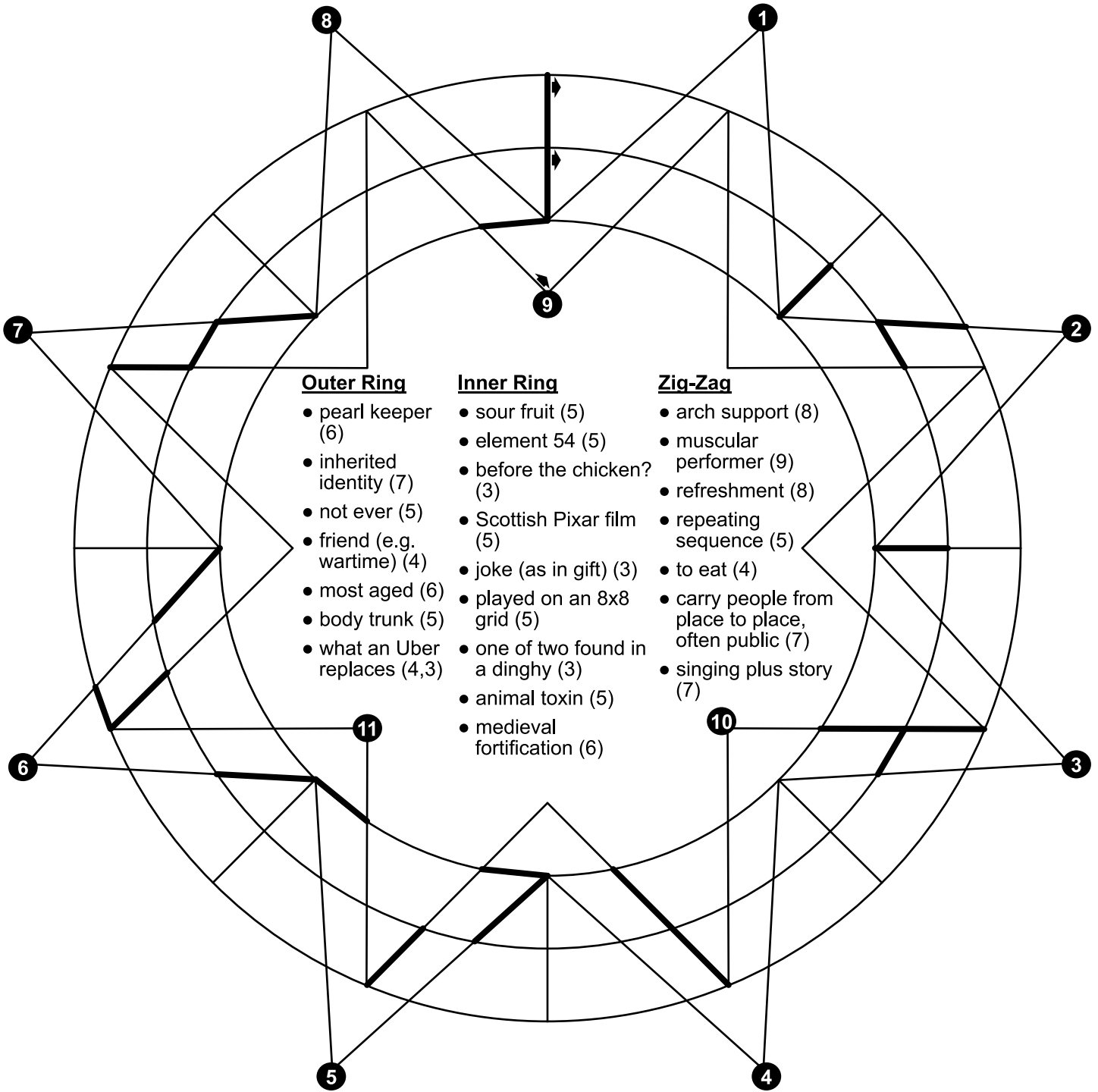
Beyond Thunderdome
