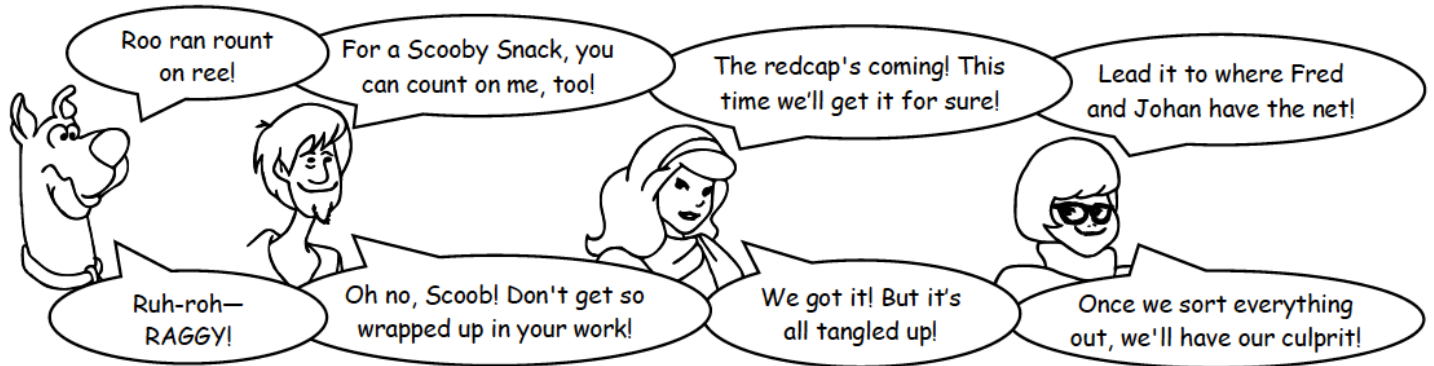
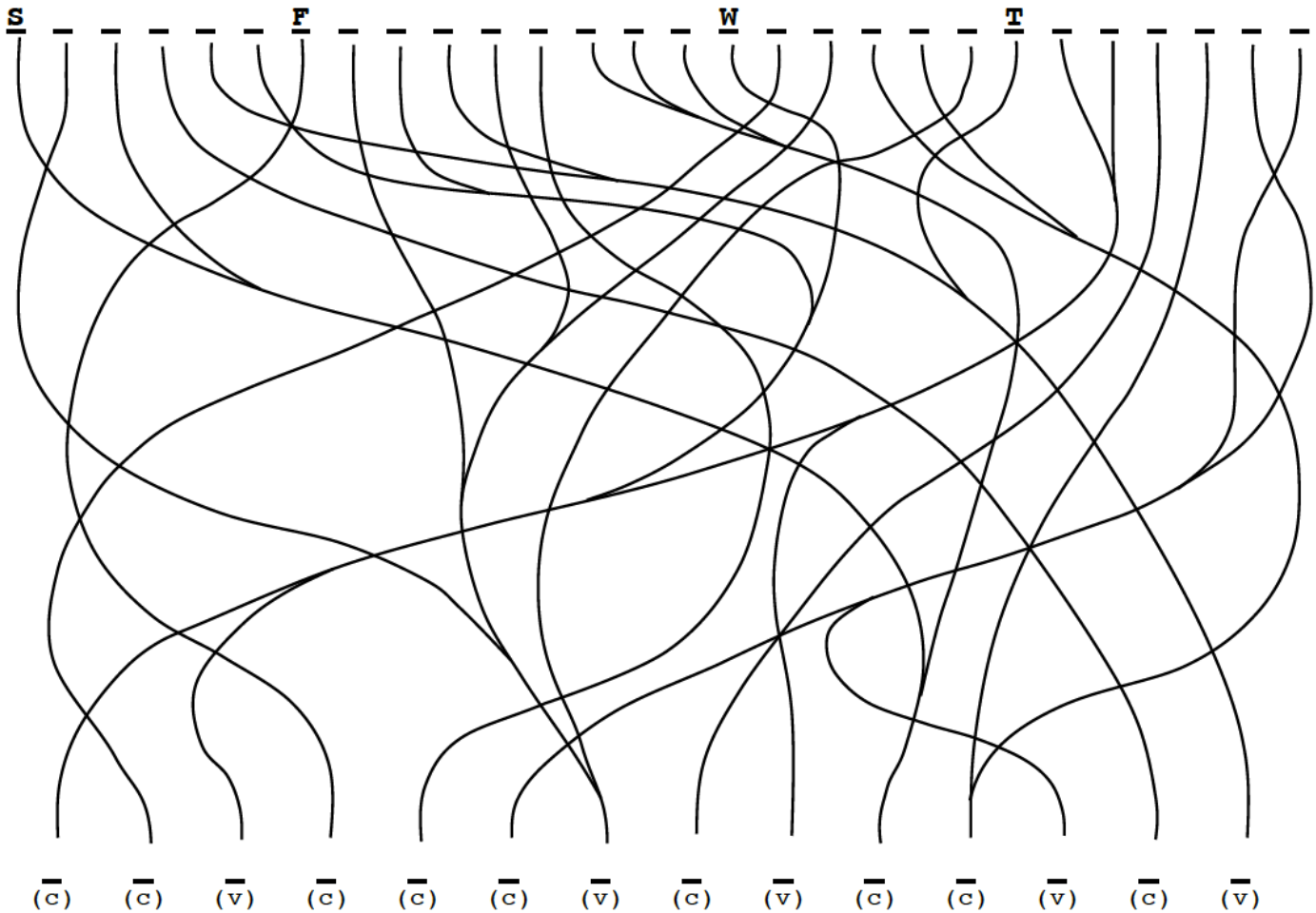


Would you do it for a Scooby Snack?
